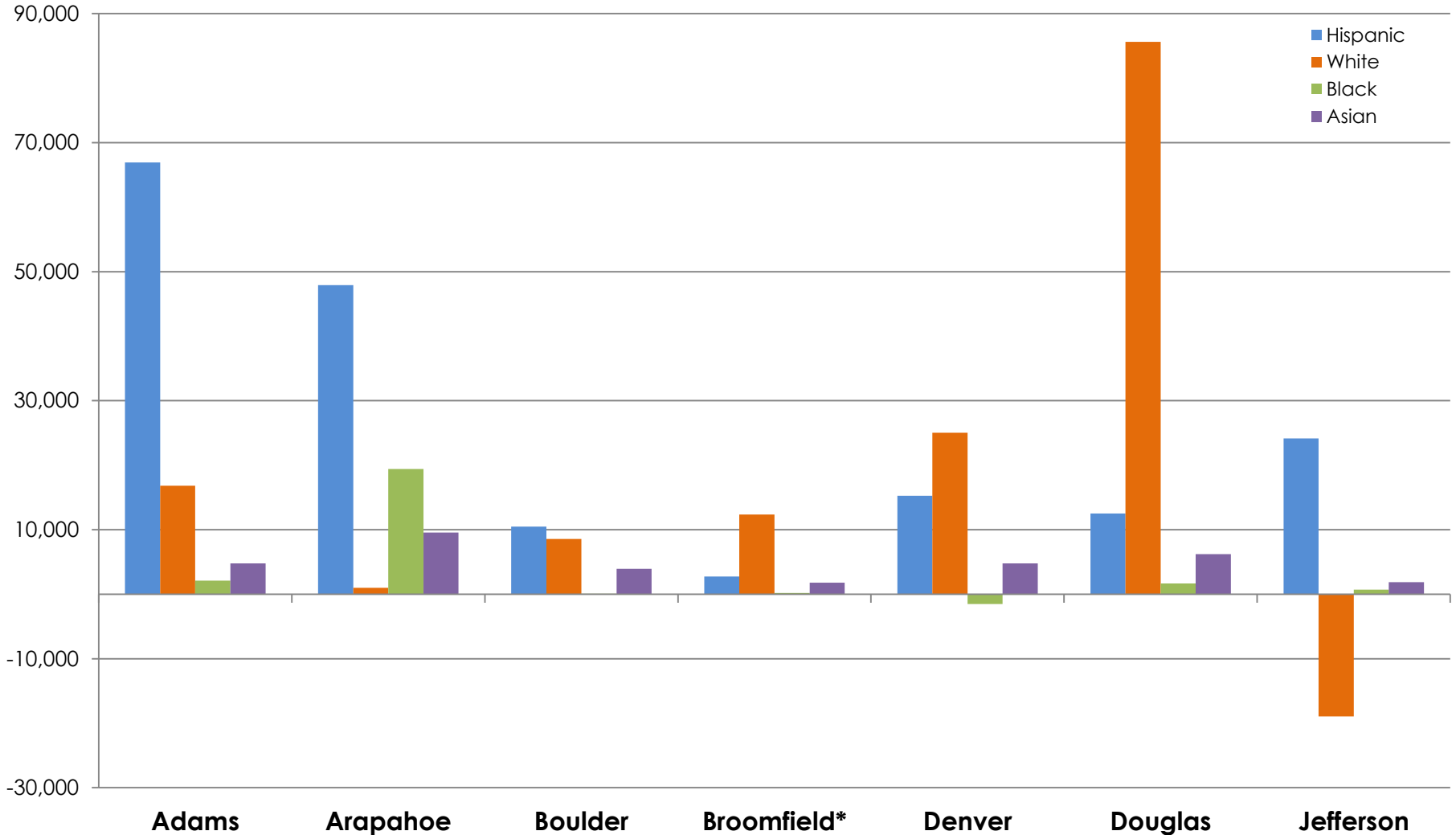


# Metro Counties Population Change by Race, 2000 to 2010

This graph shows the population change, by race/ethnic group, for the metro counties from 2000 to 2010. Adams, Arapahoe and Jefferson counties reflect the metro-wide trend of a rapidly growing suburban Hispanic population. Jefferson County's white population decreased by more than 18,000 people. If it weren't for a large increase in the Hispanic population, the county's total population would have declined. The black population in Denver decreased by more than 1,500 people in the past decade, whereas the black population in Arapahoe County increased by nearly 20,000. This reflects a pattern of black migration from Denver to Aurora and inner-ring suburbs.
