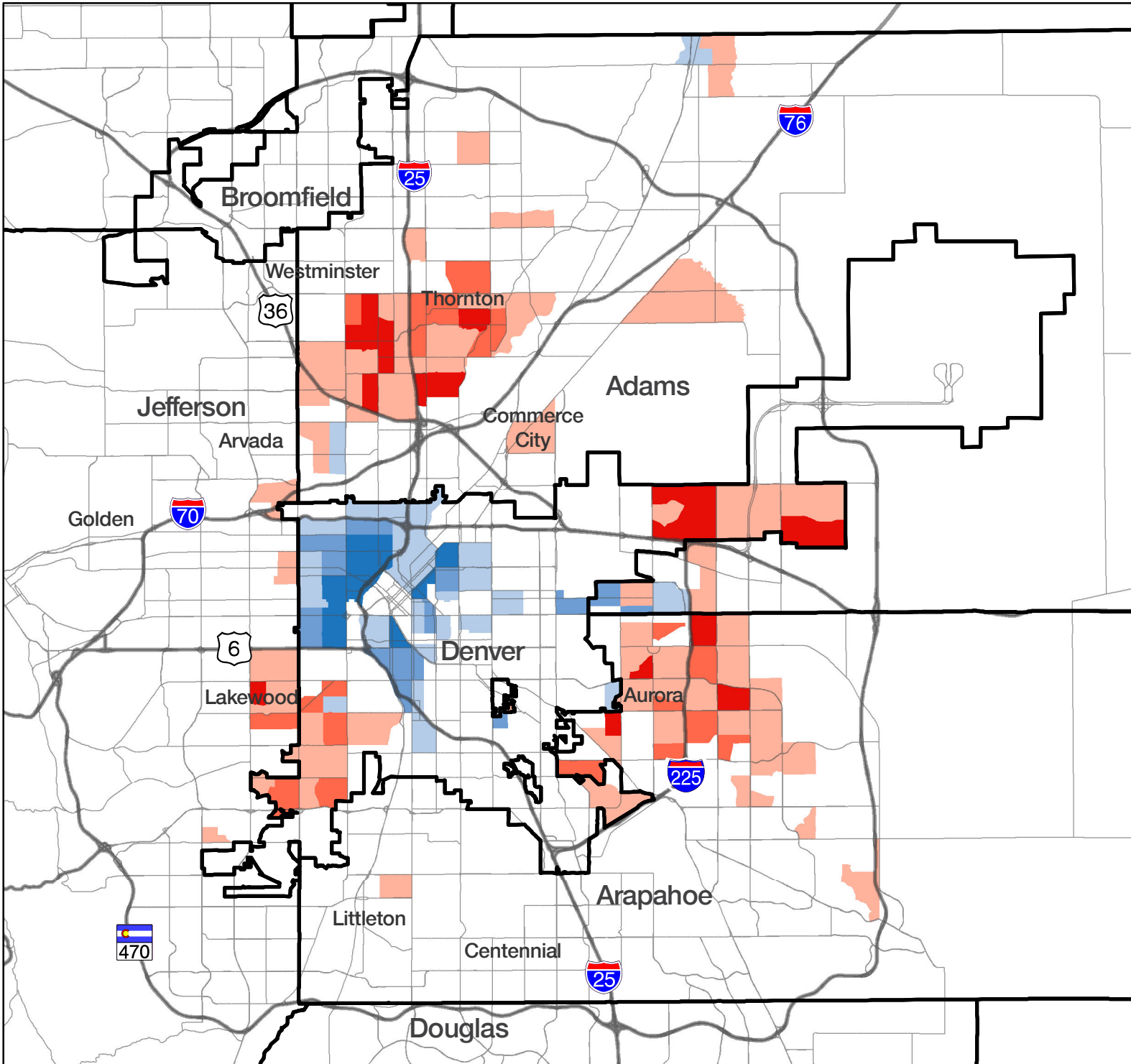
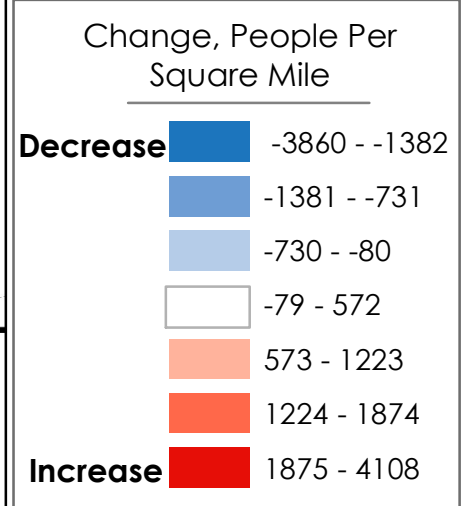


# Relative Change in Hispanic Population, 2000 to 2010

The map is shaded by standard deviation and normalized by area: White regions represent average population change (people per square mile), blue regions represent greater-than-average decline and red regions represent greater-than-average growth.
