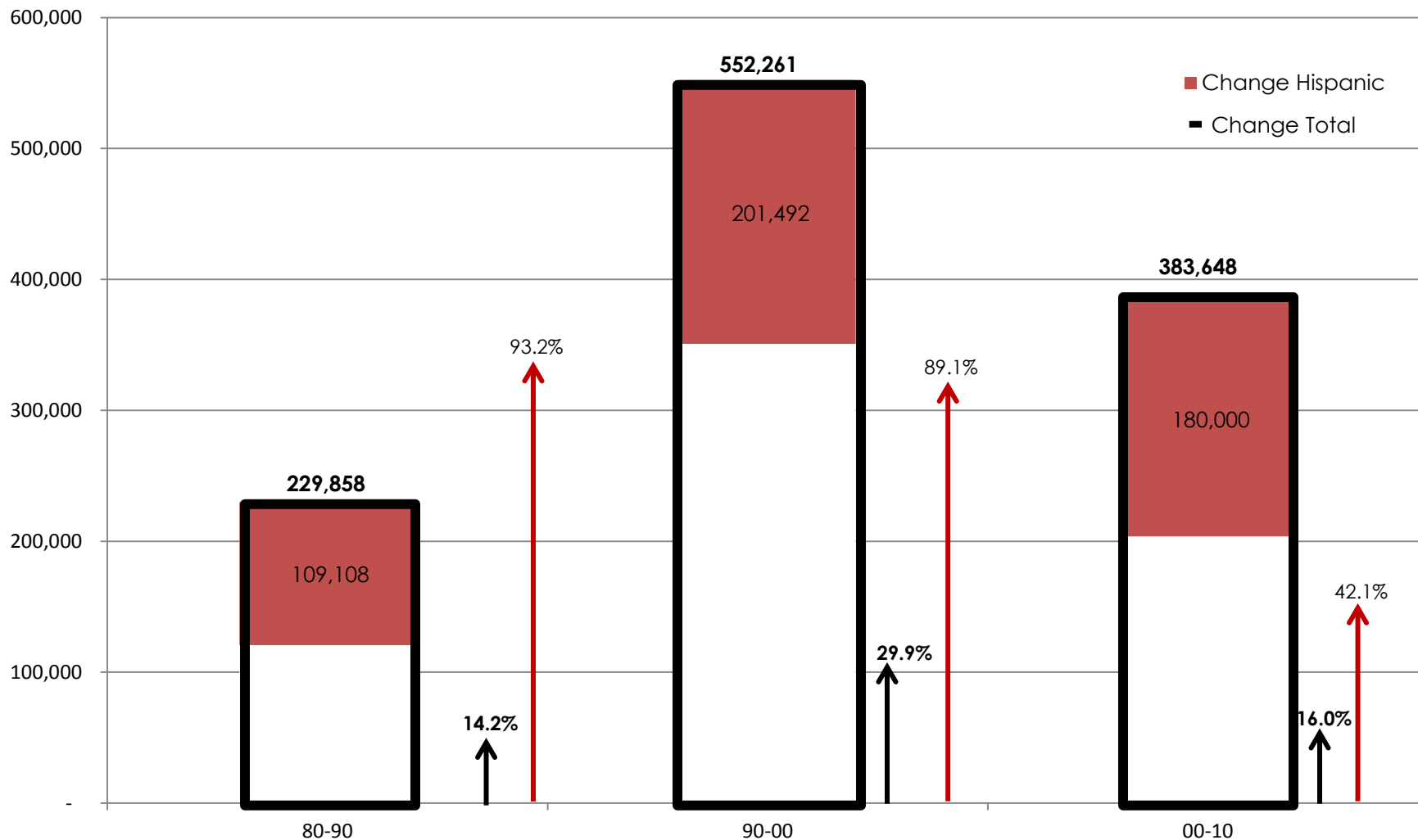


# Two Ways to Measure the Growth of the Hispanic Population:

Percent and Absolute Change in the Denver Metro Area, 1980-1990 to 2000-2010



This graph shows the population change in terms of people added and the percent growth for the Denver Metro Area over the past three decades. Although the rate of growth for the total population in the past decade was half what it was in the 90s, the metro area added 70% as many people. And although the percent growth for the Hispanic population decreased each decade, the number of Hispanics added from 2000 to 2010 is still nearly twice as many as were added in the 80s.
