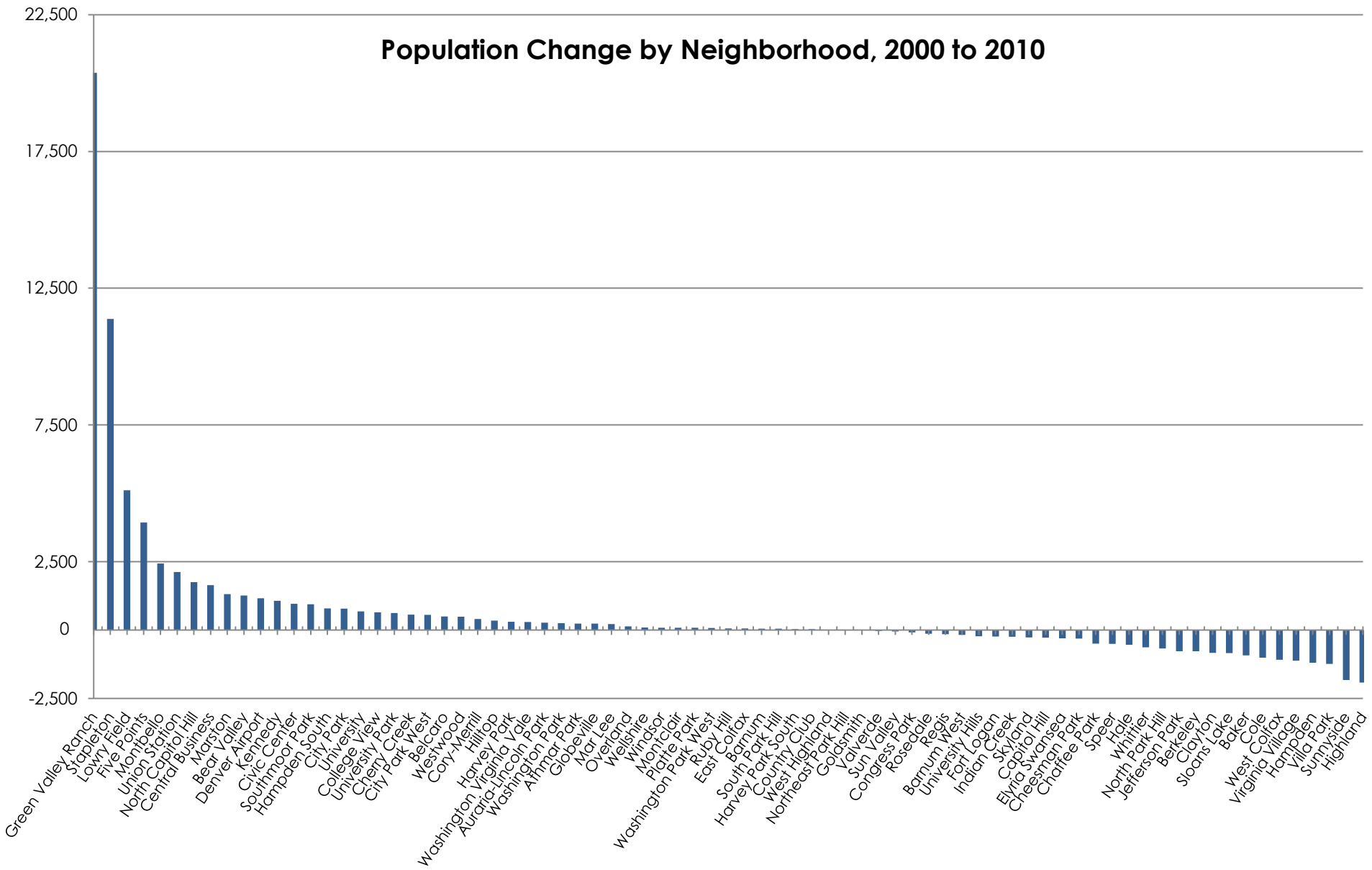


Population Change by Neighborhood, 2000 to 2010



The height of each bar represents the net change in population over the past decade for each of Denver's 77 neighborhoods: 33 showed population growth of more than 100 people, 17 had little overall change, and 27 showed a population decline of more than 100 people. Green Valley Ranch had the largest growth, adding 20,379 people, and Highland had the largest decline, losing 1,924 people.
